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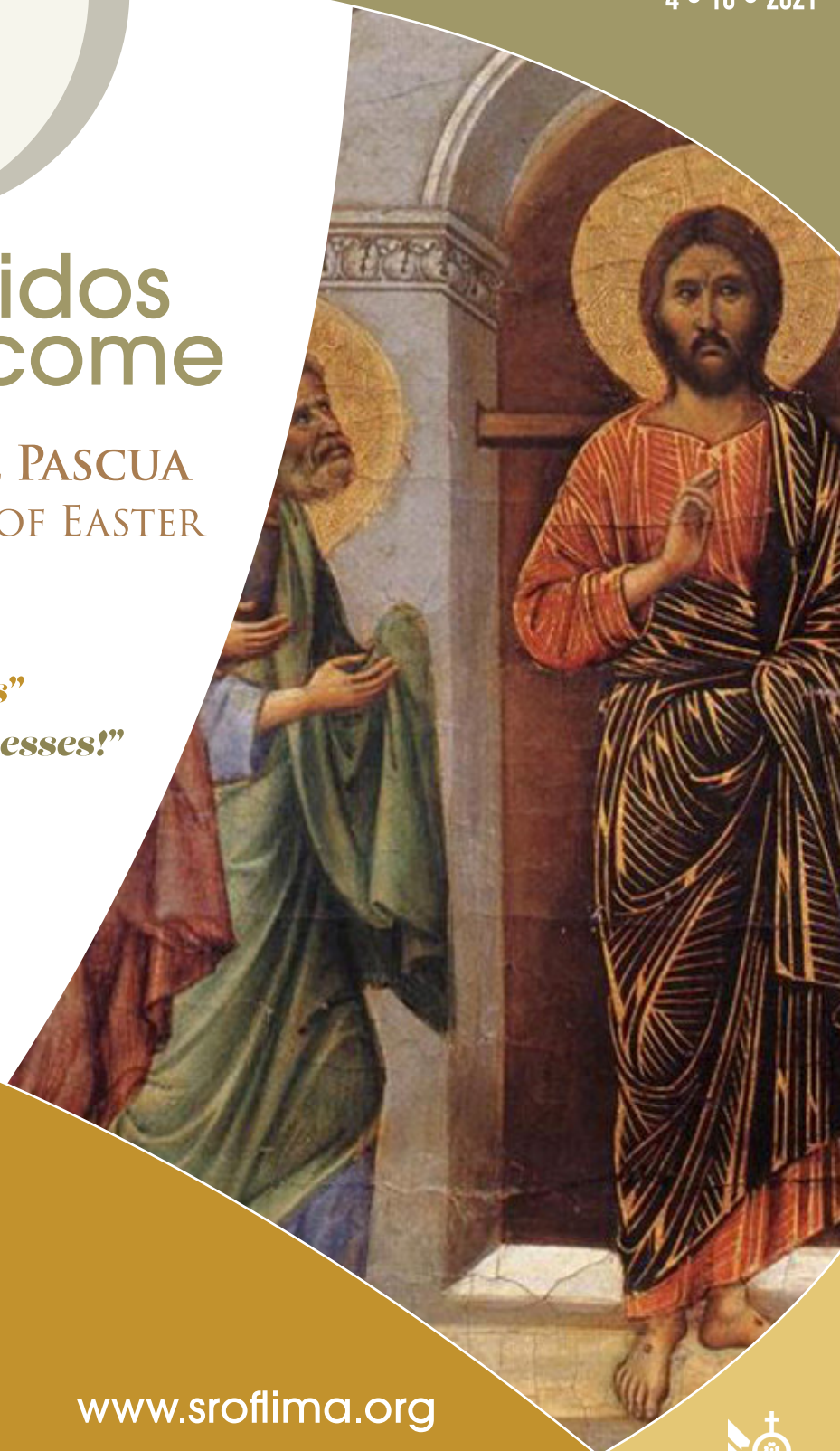

REGINA CAELI (O Queen of Heaven)

This is one of four Marian antiphons, with following versicles and prayers, traditionally said or sung after night prayer, immediately before going to sleep. It is said throughout Eastertide. (That is, from Easter Day through Pentecost, the seventh Sunday after Easter.

The Regina caeli is also said in place of the Angelus during Eastertide.

R. For He whom you did merit to bear, alleluia.
V. Has risen, as he said, alleluia.
R. Pray for us to God, alleluia.
V. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia.
R. For the Lord has truly risen, alleluia.

Let us pray. O God, who gave joy to the world through the resurrection of Thy Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, grant we beseech Thee, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may obtain the joys of everlasting life. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

Regina Coeli (o Regina Caeli) es el nombre de una oración mariana y cristológica de la Iglesia católica en honor de la Virgen. Son las palabras latinas con que abre el himno pascual a la Santísima Virgen María que traducidas al español son "Reina del cielo", es una composición litúrgica a manera de felicitación a María por la resurrección de su Hijo Jesucristo.

G: Reina del cielo, alégrate, aleluya.
T: Porque el Señor, a quien has llevado en tu vientre, aleluya.

G: Ha resucitado según su palabra, aleluya.
T: Ruega al Señor por nosotros, aleluya.

G: Goza y alégrate Virgen María, aleluya.
T: Porque en verdad ha resucitado el Señor, aleluya.

LITURGÍA DEL DÍA

Primera Lectura Hch 3, 13-15. 17-19

En aquellos días, Pedro tomó la palabra y dijo: "El Dios de Abraham, de Isaac y de Jacob, el Dios de nuestros padres, ha glorificado a su siervo Jesús, a quien ustedes entregaron a Pilato, y a quien rechazaron en su presencia, cuando él ya había decidido ponerlo en libertad. Rechazaron al santo, al justo, y pidieron el indulto de un asesino; han dado muerte al autor de la vida, pero Dios lo resucitó de entre los muertos y de ello nosotros somos testigos.

Ahora bien, hermanos, yo sé que ustedes han obrado por ignorancia, de la misma manera que sus jefes; pero Dios cumplió así lo que había predicho por boca de los profetas: que su Mesías tenía que padecer. Por lo tanto, arrepíentanse y conviértanse, para que se les perdonen sus pecados".

Salmo Responsorial

R. (7a) En ti, señor, confío. Aleluya.

Segunda Lectura 1 Jn 2, 1-5a

Hijitos míos: Les escribo esto para que no pequen. Pero, si alguien peca, tenemos como intercesor ante el Padre, a Jesucristo, el justo. Porque él se ofreció como víctima de expiación por nuestros pecados, y no sólo por los nuestros, sino por los del mundo entero.

En esto tenemos una prueba de que conocemos a Dios, en que cumplimos sus mandamientos. El que dice: "Yo lo conozco", pero no cumple sus mandamientos, es un mentiroso y la verdad no está en él. Pero en aquel que cumple su palabra, el amor de Dios ha llegado a su plenitud, y precisamente en esto conocemos que estamos unidos a él.

Evangelio Lc 24, 35-48

Cuando los dos discípulos regresaron de Emaús y llegaron al sitio donde estaban reunidos los apóstoles, les contaron lo que les había pasado en el camino y cómo habían reconocido a Jesús al partir el pan.

Mientras hablaban de esas cosas, se presentó Jesús en medio de ellos y les dijo: "La paz esté con ustedes". Ellos, desconcertados y llenos de temor, creían ver un fantasma. Pero él les dijo: "No teman; soy yo. ¿Por qué se espantan? ¿Por qué surgen dudas en su interior? Miren mis manos y mis pies. Soy yo en persona. Tóquenme y convézanse: un fantasma no tiene ni carne ni huesos, como ven que tengo yo". Y les mostró las manos y los pies. Pero como ellos no acababan de creer de pura alegría y seguían atónitos, les dijo: "¿Tienen aquí algo de comer?" Le ofrecieron un trozo de pescado asado; él lo tomó y se puso a comer delante de ellos.

Después les dijo: "Lo que ha sucedido es aquello de que les hablaba yo, cuando aún estaba con ustedes: que tenía que cumplirse todo lo que estaba escrito de mí en la ley de Moisés, en los profetas y en los salmos".

Entonces les abrió el entendimiento para que comprendieran las Escrituras y les dijo: "Está escrito que el Mesías tenía que padecer y había de resucitar de entre los muertos al tercer día, y que en su nombre se había de predicar a todas las naciones, comenzando por Jerusalén, la necesidad de volverse a Dios para el perdón de los pecados. Ustedes son testigos de esto".

Reading I Acts 3:13-15, 17-19

Peter said to the people: "The God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified his servant Jesus, whom you handed over and denied in Pilate's presence when he had decided to release him.

You denied the Holy and Righteous One and asked that a murderer be released to you. The author of life you put to death, but God raised him from the dead; of this we are witnesses. Now I know, brothers, that you acted out of ignorance, just as your leaders did; but God has thus brought to fulfillment what he had announced beforehand through the mouth of all the prophets, that his Christ would suffer. Repent, therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be wiped away."

Reading II 1 Jn 2:1-5a

My children, I am writing this to you so that you may not commit sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous one. He is expiation for our sins, and not for our sins only but for those of the whole world. The way we may be sure that we know him is to keep his commandments. Those who say, "I know him," but do not keep his commandments are liars, and the truth is not in them. But whoever keeps his word, the love of God is truly perfected in him.

Gospel Lk 24:35-48

The two disciples recounted what had taken place on the way, and how Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of bread.

While they were still speaking about this, he stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you."

But they were startled and terrified and thought that they were seeing a ghost.

Then he said to them, "Why are you troubled? And why do questions arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself.

Touch me and see, because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have."

And as he said this, he showed them his hands and his feet.

While they were still incredulous for joy and were amazed, he asked them, "Have you anything here to eat?"

They gave him a piece of baked fish;

he took it and ate it in front of them.

He said to them,

"These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the law of Moses and in the prophets and psalms must be fulfilled."

Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures.

And he said to them, "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem.

You are witnesses of these things."

EASTER PEOPLE

Our God is the God of all creation, the God of life, the maker of all things in the heavens and on earth.

We feel that especially at this time of year, when we see so many little signs of new life and growth everywhere. Flowers and plants are beginning to bloom; we hear the songs of the birds outside our windows.

We should reflect more on the meaning of creation and the theology of creation — on the beauty and wonders of the world around us, on how God's glory and intentions are revealed in the things that he has made for us.

The earth is the Lord's and all that is in it, the psalmist tells us.

When the psalmist surveys all of the Lord's works, from the moon and stars above to the earth and seas below, he is amazed at God's greatest achievement — the human person, man and woman created out of love in God's image: "What is man that you are mindful of him. ... You have made him little less than God, crowned him with glory and honor."

The Bible is the book of life. It is also a book about life, telling the world's story from its creation, which we read about on the first pages, to the new creation, the new heavens, and new earth, which we read about on its final pages.

At the heart of the story is the living relationship of God with the human person he created.

The ones who put Jesus to death could not understand this. They accused Jesus of being a man who was trying to make himself God.

They could not imagine that God would have the humility, the daring, or the love to enter into this world that he created and to share in the life of the creature he made in his image.

St. Paul calls Jesus the "firstborn of all creation" and the "firstborn from the dead."

"In him was life," St. John tells us at the start of his Gospel. And the promise that Jesus makes to us is the promise of life. "I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly," he said.

That is why Jesus was born. This is why he lived and why he suffered and died. And that is why he was "born" from the dead three days later.

He rose from the dead to give us life. Not physical life or biological life. He had already given us that, in our birth to our human parents. What he comes to share is spiritual life and divine life. Life like he has life. Life as a child of God. Life that is eternal.

Our God is the God of the living, not the dead. He makes us, each and every one of us, to be with him. Not only for a little while, for the span of our mortal lives. No. God makes us to be with him for all eternity.

The joy of Easter is the joy of knowing that a great battle — the great struggle between life and death — has been won.

Easter is the triumph of the Lord, it is the victory of divine love and life over human sin and death.

Our Lord's victory should fill us with hope, because his victory is your victory and mine.

Easter tells us that creation has a destination, a purpose. What is born is not born to die, but to live. Easter tells us that God's love is stronger than death.

If we remain in his love, if we live by his teachings and walk in the path he sets before us, no matter what might happen to us — even affliction, sickness, persecution, violence — with Jesus we will conquer, we will have life.

His resurrection is a promise and an invitation to believe, to trust, to build our lives on this foundation. Whatever struggles we face, we can meet them with this certainty that we are destined for eternity.

Jesus tells us, *"I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die."*

And then Our Lord asks us, "Do you believe this?"

This Easter let us say yes again to Our Lord's invitation.

The power of the resurrection is the power that we have now to live as "Easter people," a people alive in the risen Christ, a people who know we are on the way to heaven, and the way to heaven is the way of love.

Pray for me and I will pray for you.

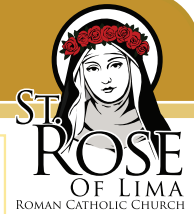
